Saturday Tutoring Program 2011-2012 A partnership with Southeastern Louisiana University College of Education

The FHS Freshman Academy will offer Saturday tutoring to all FHS freshman. The purpose of the program is to give students additional time to work on assignments, receive tutoring, recover possible points on assignments, and retake failed tests for a maximum grade of 70%. On most Saturdays, students from Southeastern Louisiana University's College of Education will be on hand to assist students with their assignments. All tutoring sessions will be facilitated by an FHS Faculty member.

Tutoring will be held from **8:00am until 12:00pm** in the **FHS library** on the following dates:

Student Grade Recovery Procedures:

- Students can **only re-take 3 FAILED tests PER SEMESTER in core classes only for a maximum grade of 70%. This opportunity does NOT apply to honors and gifted courses.**
 - Tests missed due to absenteeism are **NOT** subject to this program.
 - Students must request a **Test Retake Application** from their teacher and return the completed application it to their teacher at least **ONE WEEK BEFORE the scheduled make-up date.**
 - Students will study for 2 hours before being allowed to re- take the test.
- **Students may recover possible points on class assignments and/or homework (no more than 2 weeks overdue) completed at Saturday Tutoring.**
 - The amount of points recovered is decided by your child's individual teacher.
 - In order to receive points the assignment must be signed by the Saturday tutoring facilitator.
